

SECOND LEVEL EXPERIMENTAL ACADEMIC COURSE in MUSICAL DISCIPLINES OF INTERPRETATION AND COMPOSITION

CLARINET SCHOOL

Prerequisites for Admission

- a) First Level Academic Diploma, a Degree or equivalent; or a Conservatory Diploma in conjunction with a Senior Secondary School Diploma or any equivalent.
- b) Entrance exam

NOTE: Course credits may be attributed for previous training courses.

All candidates must attach to their application a detailed curriculum of their previous musical education, particularly if relevant to the requested course or profile. Candidates applying for courses that require performance exams with an accompanist or as part of a chamber group must organize this themselves.

Entrance Exam

Candidates must present a programme lasting approximately 20 minutes, featuring important works for their chosen instrument, played from memory. They must also take sight-reading and transposition tests. The Exam Board reserves the right to only listen to a part of the programme.

Type of final exam and procedure

The final exam includes:

- a) discussion of a written dissertation, prepared in collaboration with a teacher from the disciplines studied.
- b) performance of a concert programme lasting approximately 1 hour, previously approved by the Course Council. This programme may contain works already performed for previous tests up to a maximum of around twenty minutes.
