Academic course to take a 2nd level experimental Academic Diploma in MUSICAL DISCIPLINES OF INTERPRETATION AND COMPOSITION

LIED AND ORATORIO in German

(COD./26 - M.D. no. 119 of 20.02.2013)

Prerequisites for Admission

1) First Level Academic Diploma, a Degree or equivalent; or a Conservatory Diploma in conjunction with a Senior Secondary School Diploma or any equivalent

2) ENTRANCE EXAM

Candidates must resent a programme of their own choice consisting of 3 arias taken from Oratorios, Cantatas or Masses, plus 4 *Lieder* from different periods and in different styles. The *Lieder* must be sung from memory. Candidates may begin with a work of their choice, and then the commission will choose the other works to be performed.

TYPE OF FINAL EXAM AND PROCEDURE

The final exam includes:

a) discussion of a written dissertation, prepared in collaboration with a teacher from the disciplines studied.

b) performance of a concert programme lasting approximately 1 hour, previously approved by the Course Council. This programme may contain works already performed for previous tests up to a maximum of around twenty minutes.
